# 3. Turn On and Start

## 3-1. Wizard Setup (Setup Assistant)

During fist booting-up procedure, you will meet the Setup Assistant (Wizard Setup) as shown below.

Select OK and confirm with the OK key to start Wizard Setup. If you want to run the set up after booting up, you can select CANCEL at the 1<sup>st</sup> step.

## 3-2. Turn ON for normal use

Switch the unit on at the rear of the N25AMP. The power LED will be ON with green color. Power

it on using the remote control or the power button on the front of the N25AMP. The power LED color will be changed to blue and start booting – The N25AMP should take about 30~40 seconds to boot up as it is looking to see if a network is connected.

After the N25AMP is powered ON, the below screen will show up in sequence.





It allows N25AMP to equalize and normalize loudness for individual track or album. This avoids the common problem of having to manually adjust volume levels between tracks when playing audio files from albums that have been mastered at different loudness levels. X Default: OFF

#### 5. What is the Music database (Music DB) and how to make it

To make a Music DB at your N25AMP, you need storage like external USB HDD or NAS which contains music files. Connect them to the N25AMP. Go to the Browser and just place the cursor on the folder containing the music you want for Music DB

#### 5-1. What is the Music database (Music DB)

Only tag info and metadata of music files stored in multiple folders of storages connected to the N25AMP will be scanned and collected in the Music DB. The music file itself remains in its original folder. So, annoying functions such as MusicDB backup, restore or exporting, etc are no longer necessary. The Music DB feature will facilitate classification by album, genre, title, artist, etc, editing and searching.

# 8. Playlist

Genre

The N25 has three (3) kinds of playlist. The 1<sup>st</sup> one is just the normal Playlist function, the 2<sup>nd</sup> is 'My Playlist', and the 3<sup>rd</sup> is 'Advanced My Playlist'. The normal Playlist does not disappear by stopping or powering off. However, My Playlist and Advanced My Playlist are virtual playlists. The virtual playlist is removed by stopping or powering off.

X NOTE: If you run 'My Playlist function' or 'Advanced My Playlist function', the My Playlist is created automatically in the Playlist folder.



# 20. Troubleshooting

- 1. There is no power.
  - 1-1. Make sure the power cord is connected.
  - 1-2. Check the N25AMP is switched ON at the rear panel.
  - 1-3. Make sure the plug is fully inserted into the wall socket.
- 2. The N25AMP does not respond to the remote control.
  - 2-1. Replace remote batteries
  - 2-2. Check for interference from other IR sources
  - 2-3. Reduce the distance between the remote control and the N25AMP.
- 3. The N25AMP does not display the network-shared folder on your PC
  - 3-1. Check the network connection status between the N25AMP and your PC

3-2. According to the network environment there may be a time delay in connecting to the network.

3-3. Try rebooting the N25AMP and configure the network setup again.

- 4. No sound from the speaker during music file play back
  - 4-1. Check if the MUTE function in ON
  - 4-2. Check all cables connected to each device.

- 4-3. Check the volume level
- 4-4. Check Audio settings at SETUP
- There is a hum coming from the speaker.
   Make sure that all cable connections are secure.
